Purpose of Funds

- Part of Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Fund authorized under ARPA
- Intended to address economic fallout of the pandemic and lay the foundation for a strong and equitable recovery



FY 2021-22 Covid-19 Funds

- <u>Resolution 21-17</u>: \$81 million to develop a grant program for low- and moderate-income households to build accessory dwelling units
 - Strengthen communities disproportionately impacted by Covid-19 by creating opportunities for:
 - > Multi-generational, extended family households
 - > Equity and intergenerational wealth building
 - > Additional income
 - Focus on serving socially disadvantaged areas:
 - Qualified Census Tracts (50% at 60% AMI)
 - High Segregation/Poverty and Low Resource (TCAC Opportunity Map)





Summary of ADU Program

- Eligibility
 - Below 80% AMI
 - Below CalHFA income limits and CLTV > 80%
 - > In Qualified Census Tracks (50% at 60% AMI), no CLTV test
- \$25,000 grant for pre-development costs to build an accessory dwelling unit
 - Include, but not limited to: permits, impact fees, surveys, designs
