How to Observe and Offer Public Comments at remote CalHFA Board of Directors Meetings

The Board meetings of the California Housing Finance Agency will be available to view remotely pursuant to California Government Code Section 11133.

- All open session meetings of the CalHFA Board of Directors are recorded and posted online for public access.
- By addressing the Board, you agree to be recorded and broadcast on video.
- All meeting agendas, notices, and materials are posted on the [Board Meeting](#) section at www.calhfa.ca.gov.



How To View The Meeting via Zoom

REGISTER for the meeting by clicking on the link as shown on the meeting Agenda or Notice.

CHOOSE Register with your Zoom Account *or*

Register with your email and enter the verification code sent to the email address you provided

JOIN the meeting when it starts by clicking on the link in the confirmation email you received after registering.

How To Provide Comments via Zoom

During the public comment portion of the meeting, indicate you would like to ask a question or address the Board by clicking on the “raised hand” icon. This will alert the meeting organizer that you have a question. Your comment will be part of the official public record.

How To Provide eComments

E-mail written comments to feedback@calhfa.ca.gov in advance of the meeting, up until 5 p.m. the day before the meeting. **Please include the following with your comment:**

- Your first and last name (not required, you may still submit without identifying yourself).
- The agenda item you are commenting on.
- Your comment becomes part of the meeting’s official record.
